

 - That concluded that Northstowe would not have significant effect on Natura 2000 or Ramsar sites...






Advice by a committee member is given on the understanding that it does not constrain the Group in any way.

Cottenham Parish Council is a statutory consultee on planning applications, and contact can be made with the Council through the Parish Clerk.

Mereham inquiry

- Steven Poole represented the group at the Mereham inquiry on 17th October 2007
- Based on the group's written submission from 18th June 2006
 - Increased road traffic
 - Increased flood risk
 - Destruction of landscape/views
- Secretary of State will issue decision by 9th September 2008

 - Now based on the revised Design Statement SPD...








Applications in Cottenham Parish



Applications by Type




Applications by SCDC Decision




